<u>In order to avoid contamination</u>, tenants are asked to separate their recyclables into the following two categories:

- 1. Paper/Newspaper/Cardboard
- 2. Plastic/Glass/Metal

NOTE:

- ALL food containers must be rinsed prior to recycling.
